A BILL

1	SECTION 1. EXEMPTION FOR CERTAIN FERRY BORNE
2	TRAILER CARGO FROM HARBOR MAINTE
3	NANCE TAX.
4	(a) In General.—Section 4462 of the Internal Rev-
5	enue Code of 1986 (relating to definitions and special
6	rules) is amended by redesignating subsection (i) as sub-
7	section (j) and by inserting after subsection (h) the fol-
8	lowing new subsection:
9	"(i) Exemption for Certain Ferry Borne
10	Trailer Cargo.—
11	"(1) In general.—The tax imposed by section
12	4461(a) shall not apply to cargo which is qualified
13	ferry trailer cargo.
14	"(2) Qualified ferry trailer cargo.—For
15	purposes of paragraph (1), the term 'qualified ferry
16	trailer cargo' means cargo which is on or in a truck
17	trailer or semitrailer parked on a ferry which is op-
18	erating between two ports for the sole purpose of
19	transporting such trailers and trucks between such
20	ports due to traffic congestion on the nearest inter-
21	national bridge serving the area in which such ports
22	are located.".
23	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
24	subsection (a) shall apply to port use after December 31
25	2004.
