#### 1 SEC. 2. APPLICABILITY.

- 2 (a) In General.—Subject to subsection (b), the

- 5 (b) Pending Petitions, Investigations, and De-
- 6 TERMINATIONS.—The amendments made by section 1
- 7 shall not affect any petition filed before, or investigation
- 8 pending on, the effective date set forth in subsection (a),
- 9 under chapter 1 of title III of the Trade Act of 1974. Such
- 10 petitions and investigations shall proceed as if section 1
- 11 had not been enacted. The amendments made by section
- 12 1 shall not affect any determination made or action taken
- 13 under chapter 1 of title III of the Trade Act of 1974 be-
