## **AN ACT**

To reauthorize the Steel and Aluminum Energy Conservation and Technology Competitiveness Act of 1988.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## 1 SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS.

2 (a) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
3 9 of the Steel and Aluminum Energy Conservation and
4 Technology Competitiveness Act of 1988 (15 U.S.C.
5 5108) is amended to read as follows:

## 6 "SEC. 9. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

7 "There are authorized to be appropriated to the Sec8 retary to carry out this Act for fiscal year 2005, an
9 amount equal to the amount appropriated for the same
10 purposes for fiscal year 2004, and \$20,000,000 for each
11 of the fiscal years 2006 through 2009.".

(b) STEEL PROJECT PRIORITIES.—Section 4(c)(1) of
the Steel and Aluminum Energy Conservation and Technology Competitiveness Act of 1988 (15 U.S.C.
5103(c)(1)) is amended—

16 (1) in subparagraph (H), by striking "coatings
17 for sheet steels" and inserting "sheet and bar
18 steels"; and

19 (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-20 paragraph:

21 "(K) The development of technologies22 which reduce greenhouse gas emissions.".

23 (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—The Steel and
24 Aluminum Energy Conservation and Technology Competi25 tiveness Act of 1988 is further amended—

26 (1) by striking section 7 (15 U.S.C. 5106); and HR 3890 RFS 1 (2) in section 4(b)—

2	(A) in the subsection heading, by inserting
3	"AND REPORT" after "MANAGEMENT PLAN";
4	(B) by striking "Within 6 months after the
5	date of enactment of this Act" and inserting
6	"Not later than 6 months after the date of en-
7	actment of the Act enacting this sentence";
8	(C) by striking "to expand the steel re-
9	search and development initiative to include
10	aluminum and"; and
11	(D) by inserting ", and shall transmit such
12	plan to Congress" after "carry out the purposes
13	of this Act".
