## A BILL

To authorize construction of a new (replacement) medical center for the Department of Veterans Affairs in the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico at a site to be selected pursuant to a study by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs and Secretary of Defense as suitable for a new Federal medical center in the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico that would best serve the needs of both veterans and Department of Defense medical beneficiaries in Puerto Rico.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

1	SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF MAJOR MEDICAL FACILITY
2	PROJECT, COMMONWEALTH OF PUERTO
3	RICO.
4	The Secretary of Veterans Affairs may carry out a
5	major medical facility project for the construction of a new
6	(replacement) medical center in the Commonwealth of
7	Puerto Rico, in an amount not to exceed \$450,000,000
8	The project shall be carried out at the site selected pursu-
9	ant to section 3.
10	SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.
11	(a) In General.—There is authorized to be appro-
12	priated to the Secretary of Veterans Affairs for fiscal year
13	2005 for the Construction, Major Projects, account
14	\$450,000,000 for the project authorized in section 1.
15	(b) LIMITATION.—The project authorized in section
16	1 may only be carried out using—
17	(1) funds appropriated for fiscal year 2005 pur-
18	suant to the authorization of appropriations in sub-
19	section (a);
20	(2) funds appropriated for Construction, Major
21	Projects, for a fiscal year before fiscal year 2005
22	that remain available for obligation; and
23	(3) funds appropriated for Construction, Major
24	Projects, for fiscal year 2005 for a category of activ-
25	ity not specific to a project.

### SEC. 3. STUDY OF SITE FOR NEW MEDICAL CENTER IN 2 COMMONWEALTH OF PUERTO RICO. 3 (a) Study.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs and the Secretary of Defense shall conduct a joint study of 4 5 the locations in the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico specified in subsection (b) to determine which of those two loca-7 tions would be the preferable site for a new Federal medical center in the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico to serve the needs of both veterans and Department of Defense 9 medical beneficiaries in Puerto Rico. 10 11 (b) Specification of Sites.—The sites to be studied under subsection (a) are the following: 13 (1) Sabana Seca, Puerto Rico. 14 (2) Fort Buchanan, Puerto Rico. 15 (c) Report to Congress.—The two Secretaries shall jointly submit to Congress a report setting forth the results of the study, including the recommendation of the 17 Secretaries for the site for a new Federal medical center 18 19 in the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico. The report shall be 20 submitted not later than six months after the date of the

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enactment of this Act.

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
