3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "City of Oxnard Water
- 5 Recycling and Desalination Act of 2004".

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Reclamation Wastewater and
4 Groundwater Study and Facilities Act (title XVI of Public
5 Law 102–575; 43 U.S.C. 390h et seq.) is amended by add6 ing at the end the following:

7 "SEC. 1636. OXNARD, CALIFORNIA, WATER RECLAMATION, 8 REUSE, AND TREATMENT PROJECT.

"(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-9 tion with the City of Oxnard, California, may participate 10 11 in the design, planning, and construction of permanent facilities for the GREAT project to reclaim, reuse, and treat 12 13 impaired waters water in the area of Oxnard, California. 14 "(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the costs 15 of the project described in subsection (a) shall not exceed 16 25 percent of the total cost.

17 "(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide
18 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project
19 described in subsection (a).".
