Mrs. MILLER of Michigan (for herself and Mr. KNOLLENBERG) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To authorize the extension of nondiscriminatory treatment (normal trade relations treatment) to the products of Ukraine.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF APPLICATION OF TITLE IV**
4 **OF THE TRADE ACT OF 1974 TO UKRAINE.**

5 (a) PRESIDENTIAL DETERMINATIONS AND EXTEN-
6 SIONS OF NONDISCRIMINATORY TREATMENT.—Notwith-
7 standing any provision of title IV of the Trade Act of 1974
8 (19 U.S.C. 2431 et seq.), the President may—

9 (1) determine that such title should no longer
10 apply to Ukraine; and

1 (2) after making a determination under para-
2 graph (1) with respect to Ukraine, proclaim the ex-
3 tension of nondiscriminatory treatment (normal
4 trade relations treatment) to the products of that
5 country.

6 (b) TERMINATION OF APPLICATION OF TITLE IV.—
7 On and after the effective date of the extension under sub-
8 section (a)(2) of nondiscriminatory treatment to the prod-
9 ucts of Ukraine, chapter 1 of title IV of the Trade Act
10 of 1974 shall cease to apply to that country.
