## A BILL

To authorize the extension of nondiscriminatory treatment (normal trade relations treatment) to the products of Ukraine.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF APPLICATION OF TITLE IV
- 4 OF THE TRADE ACT OF 1974 TO UKRAINE.
- 5 (a) Presidential Determinations and Exten-
- 6 SIONS OF NONDISCRIMINATORY TREATMENT.—Notwith-
- 7 standing any provision of title IV of the Trade Act of 1974
- 8 (19 U.S.C. 2431 et seq.), the President may—
- 9 (1) determine that such title should no longer
- apply to Ukraine; and

- 1 (2) after making a determination under para-2 graph (1) with respect to Ukraine, proclaim the ex-3 tension of nondiscriminatory treatment (normal 4 trade relations treatment) to the products of that 5 country.
- 6 (b) TERMINATION OF APPLICATION OF TITLE IV.—
- 7 On and after the effective date of the extension under sub-
- 8 section (a)(2) of nondiscriminatory treatment to the prod-
- 9 ucts of Ukraine, chapter 1 of title IV of the Trade Act
- 10 of 1974 shall cease to apply to that country.
