## A BILL

For the relief of Rafael Camacho, Rosa B. Camacho, and Rosa Camacho.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR RAFAEL
CAMACHO, ROSA B. CAMACHO, AND ROSA
CAMACHO.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a) 7 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality 8 Act, Rafael Camacho, Rosa B. Camacho, and Rosa 9 Camacho shall each be eligible for issuance of an immi-10 grant visa or for adjustment of status to that of an alien 11 lawfully admitted for permanent residence upon filing an application for issuance of an immigrant visa under sec tion 204 of such Act or for adjustment of status to lawful
permanent resident.

4 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Rafael Camacho, 5 Rosa B. Camacho, or Rosa Camacho enters the United States before the filing deadline specified in subsection (c), 6 7 he or she shall be considered to have entered and remained 8 lawfully and shall, if otherwise eligible, be eligible for ad-9 justment of status under section 245 of the Immigration 10 and Nationality Act as of the date of the enactment of 11 this Act.

12 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF 13 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the application for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-14 15 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act. 16 17 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.— Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-18 idence to Rafael Camacho, Rosa B. Camacho, and Rosa 19 20 Camacho, the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper 21 officer to reduce by 3, during the current or next following 22 fiscal year, the total number of immigrant visas that are 23 made available to natives of the country of the aliens' birth 24 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality 25 Act or, if applicable, the total number of immigrant visas

1 that are made available to natives of the country of the

2 aliens' birth under section 202(e) of such Act.
