To amend the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 to establish macroeconomic congressional budgets.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Macroeconomic Budg-
- 5 eting Act of 2004".
- 6 SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF MACROECONOMIC CONGRES-
- 7 SIONAL BUDGETS.
- 8 (a) Macroeconomic Categories.—Section 301(a)
- 9 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 (2 U.S.C.

- 1 632(a)) is amended by striking paragraph (4) and by re-
- 2 designating paragraphs (5) through (7) as paragraphs (4)
- 3 through (6), respectively.
- 4 (b) Additional Matters.—Section 301(b) of the
- 5 Congressional Budget Act of 1974 (2 U.S.C. 632(b)) is
- 6 amended by striking "and" at the end of paragraph (8),
- 7 by striking the period and inserting "; and" at the end
- 8 of paragraph (9), and by adding at the end the following
- 9 new paragraph:
- "(10) set forth appropriate levels for each fiscal
 year covered by such concurrent resolution for new
 budget authority and outlays for each major functional category established by the Committees on the
 Budget (after consultation with each other), based
 on allocations of the total levels set forth pursuant

to subsection (a)(1).".
