A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to require notification to Congress and the public when waivers to certain domestic source requirements are made, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS TO DOMESTIC SOURCE RE-**
4 **QUIREMENTS.**

5 (a) NOTICE.—Section 2533a of title 10, United
6 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
7 lowing new subsection:

1 “(k) NOTIFICATION REQUIRED WHEN EXCEPTIONS
2 APPLIED.—Funds appropriated or otherwise available to
3 the Department of Defense may not be used to enter into
4 a contract to procure an item described in subsection (b)
5 pursuant to an exception in this section (as set forth in
6 subsections (c) through (h)) until—

7 “(1) a notification of the intent to apply such
8 exception is submitted to Congress and posted on
9 the website maintained by the General Services Ad-
10 ministration known as FedBizOpps.gov (or any suc-
11 cessor site); and

12 “(2) a period of 15 days has expired after the
13 date on which such notification is so submitted and
14 published.”.

15 (b) CLOTHING MATERIALS AND COMPONENTS COV-
16 ERED.—Subsection (b) of section 2533a of title 10, United
17 States Code, is amended in paragraph (1)(B) by inserting
18 before the semicolon the following: “and the materials and
19 components thereof”.
