- 3 SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS TO DOMESTIC SOURCE RE-
- 4 QUIREMENTS.
- 5 (a) Notice.—Section 2533a of title 10, United
- 6 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 7 lowing new subsection:

1	"(k) Notification Required When Exceptions
2	APPLIED.—Funds appropriated or otherwise available to
3	the Department of Defense may not be used to enter into
4	a contract to procure an item described in subsection (b)
5	pursuant to an exception in this section (as set forth in
6	subsections (c) through (h)) until—
7	"(1) a notification of the intent to apply such
8	exception is submitted to Congress and posted on
9	the website maintained by the General Services Ad-
10	ministration known as FedBizOpps.gov (or any suc-
11	cessor site); and
12	"(2) a period of 15 days has expired after the
13	date on which such notification is so submitted and
14	published.".
15	(b) CLOTHING MATERIALS AND COMPONENTS COV-
16	ERED.—Subsection (b) of section 2533a of title 10, United
17	States Code, is amended in paragraph (1)(B) by inserting
18	before the semicolon the following: "and the materials and
19	components thereof".
