A BILL

- To amend part C of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 to extend the discretionary spending limits and pay-as-you-go through fiscal year 2009.

 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Spending Control Act
3 of 2004".

4 SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF DISCRETIONARY SPENDING LIMITS.

(a) DISCRETIONARY SPENDING LIMITS.—(1) Section
251(c)(2) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit
Control Act of 1985 is amended by inserting a dash after
"2005", by redesignating the remaining portion of such
paragraph as subparagraph (B) and by moving it two ems
to the right, and by inserting after the dash the following
new subparagraph:

12 "(A) for the general purpose discretionary
13 category: \$_____ in new budget authority
14 and \$_____ in outlays; and".

15 (2) Section 251(c)(3) of the Balanced Budget and
16 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 is amended by in17 serting a dash after "2006", by redesignating the remaining
18 portion of such paragraph as subparagraph (B) and by
19 moving it two ems to the right, and by inserting after the
20 dash the following new subparagraph:

21 "(A) for the general purpose discretionary
22 category: \$_____ in new budget authority
23 and \$_____ in outlays; and".

24 (3) Section 251(c) of the Balanced Budget and Emer25 gency Deficit Control Act of 1985 is amended by redesig26 nating paragraphs (4) through (9) as paragraphs (7)

through (12) and inserting after paragraph (3) the fol lowing new paragraphs:

"(4) with respect to fiscal year 2007 for the gen-
$eral\ purpose\ discretionary\ category:\ \$____$ in
new budget authority and \$ in outlays;
"(5) with respect to fiscal year 2008 for the gen-
eral purpose discretionary category: \$ in
new budget authority and \qquad in outlays; and
"(6) with respect to fiscal year 2009 for the gen-
$eral\ purpose\ discretionary\ category:\ \$____$ in
new budget authority and \$ in outlays;".
(b) Advance Appropriations.—Section 251 of the
Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of
1985 is amended by adding at the end the following new
subsection:

16 "(d) ADVANCE APPROPRIATIONS.—In any of fiscal
17 years 2005 through 2009, discretionary advance appropria18 tions provided in appropriation Acts in excess of
19 \$______ shall be counted against the discretionary
20 spending limits for the fiscal year for which the appropria21 tion Act containing the advance appropriation is enacted.".

22 SEC. 3. EXTENSION OF PAY-AS-YOU-GO REQUIREMENT.

(a) PURPOSE.—Section 252(a) of the Balanced Budget
and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 is amended to
read as follows:

"(a) PURPOSE.—The purpose of this section is to as sure that any legislation that is enacted before October 1,
 2009, that causes a net increase in direct spending will trig ger an offsetting sequestration.".

5 (b) TIMING.—Section 252(b)(1) of the Balanced Budg6 et and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 is amended
7 by striking "any net deficit increase" and all that follows
8 through "2002," and by inserting "any net increase in di9 rect spending enacted before October 1, 2009,".

10 (c) CALCULATION OF DIRECT SPENDING INCREASE.—
11 Section 252(b)(2) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency
12 Deficit Control Act of 1985 is amended—

(1) by striking "deficit" the first place it appears and inserting "direct spending";

(2) in subparagraph (A) by striking "and receipts";

17 (3) in subparagraph (C) by striking "and re18 ceipts"; and

(4) by amending the heading to read as follows:
"CALCULATION OF DIRECT SPENDING INCREASE.—".

(d) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—(1) The heading of
section 252(c) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 is amended to read as follows:
"ELIMINATING A DIRECT SPENDING INCREASE.—".

(2) Paragraphs (1), (2), and (4) of section 252(d) of
 the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act
 of 1985 are amended by striking "or receipts" each place
 t appears.

5 (3) Section 252(e) of the Balanced Budget and Emer6 gency Deficit Control Act of 1985 is amended by striking
7 "or receipts" and by striking ", outlays, and receipts" and
8 inserting "and outlays".

9 (4) Section 254(c)(3) of the Balanced Budget and
10 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 is amended—

(A) in subparagraph (A) by striking "net deficit
increase or decrease" and by inserting "net increase
or decrease in direct spending";

(B) in subparagraph (B) by striking "amount of
deficit increase or decrease" and by inserting "increase or decrease in direct spending"; and

17 (C) in subparagraph (C) by striking "a deficit
18 increase" and by inserting "an increase in direct
19 spending".

20 SEC. 4. DEFINITIONS.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 250(c) of the Balanced
Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 is
amended by adding at the end the following new paragraphs:

1	"(20) The term 'advance appropriation' means
2	appropriations that first become available one fiscal
3	year or more beyond the fiscal year for which an ap-
4	propriation Act making such funds available is en-
5	acted.
6	((21)(A) Except as provided by subparagraph
7	(B), the term 'emergency requirement' means any
8	provision that provides new budget authority and re-
9	sulting outlays for a situation that poses a threat to
10	life, property, or national security and is—
11	"(i) sudden, quickly coming into being, and
12	not building up over time;
13	"(ii) an urgent, pressing, and compelling
14	need requiring immediate action;
15	``(iii) subject to subparagraph (B), unfore-
16	seen, unpredictable, and unanticipated; and
17	"(iv) not permanent, temporary in nature.
18	((B) An emergency that is part of an aggregate
19	level of anticipated emergencies, particularly when
20	normally estimated in advance, is not unforeseen.".
21	(b) Contingency Operations Related to Global
22	WAR ON TERRORISM.—Section 251(b)(2) of the Balanced
23	Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 is
24	amended by adding at the end the following new subpara-
25	graph:

"(I) CONTINGENCY OPERATIONS RELATED 1 2 TO GLOBAL WAR ON TERRORISM.—If supplemental appropriations for discretionary accounts 3 4 are enacted for contingency operations related to the global war on terrorism that, pursuant to 5 6 this subparagraph, the President designates as a 7 contingency operation related to the global war 8 on terrorism and the Congress so designates in 9 statute, the adjustment shall be the total of such 10 appropriations in discretionary accounts so des-11 ignated and the outlays flowing in all fiscal 12 years from such appropriations.".

(c) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—The second sentence
of section 250(c)(4)(A) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 is amended to read as
follows: "The general purpose discretionary category shall
consist of accounts designated in the joint explanatory
statement of managers accompanying the conference report
on the Spending Control Act of 2004.".

20 SEC. 5. PROJECTIONS UNDER SECTION 257.

21 Section 257(c) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency
22 Deficit Control Act of 1985 is amended by inserting after
23 paragraph (6) the following new paragraph:

24 "(7) EMERGENCIES.—New budgetary resources
25 designated under section 251(b)(2)(A) or 251(b)(2)(I)

1	shall not be assumed beyond the fiscal year for which
2	they have been enacted.".

3 SEC. 6. EXCEPTION FOR OUTLAY COMPONENTS OF EXPIR4 ING RECEIPTS LEGISLATION.

5 Section 252(d)(4) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 is amended by striking 6 7 "and" at the end of subparagraph (A), by striking the period and inserting "; and" at the end of subparagraph (B), 8 9 and by adding at the end the following new subparagraph: 10 "(C) extending provisions in the Economic Growth and Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 11 12 2001 or provisions in sections 101 through 104,

section 202, or sections 301 and 302 of the Jobs
and Growth Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of
2003.".

16 SEC. 7. REPORTS.

Subsections (c)(2) and (f)(2)(A) of section 254 of the
Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of
19 1985 are amended by striking "2002" and inserting
20 "2009".

21 SEC. 8. EXPIRATION.

and inserting "2009" and by striking "2006" and inserting
"2013".
