A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Agriculture to convey to the New Hope Cemetery Association a small parcel of National Forest System land in the State of Arkansas for use as a cemetery.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1	SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE OF SMALL PARCEL OF NATIONAL
2	FOREST SYSTEM LAND, POPE COUNTY, AR-
3	KANSAS.
4	(a) Conveyance on Condition Subsequent.—
5	Not later than 90 days after the date of enactment of this
6	Act, subject to valid existing rights and the condition stat-
7	ed in subsection (c), the Secretary of Agriculture, acting
8	through the Chief of the Forest Service (referred to in
9	this section as the "Secretary"), shall convey to the New
10	Hope Cemetery Association (referred to in this section as
11	the "association"), for no consideration, all right, title,
12	and interest of the United States in and to the parcel of
13	land described in subsection (b).
14	(b) DESCRIPTION OF LAND.—The parcel of land re-
15	ferred to in subsection (a) is the parcel of National Forest
16	System land (including any improvements on the land)
17	that—
18	(1) is known as "New Hope Cemetery Tract
19	6686e'';
20	(2) consists of approximately 1.1 acres; and
21	(3) is more particularly described as a portion
22	of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 30, T. 11,
23	R. 17W, Pope County, Arkansas.
24	(c) Condition on Use of Land.—
25	(1) In general.—The association shall use the
26	parcel conveyed under subsection (a) as a cemetery.

(2) REVERSION.—If the Secretary, after notice 1 2 to the association and an opportunity for a hearing, 3 makes a finding that the association has used or permitted the use of the parcel for any purpose 4 5 other than the purpose specified in paragraph (1), 6 and the association fails to discontinue that use, title 7 to the parcel shall, at the option of the Secretary, revert to the United States, to be administered by 8 9 the Secretary.
