3 **SECTION 1. ADDITION OF CALIFORNIA ROUTE 99 TO THE**
4 **NATIONAL HIGHWAY SYSTEM.**

5 Section 1105(c) of the Intermodal Surface Transpor-
6 tation Efficiency Act of 1991 (105 Stat. 2032; 112 Stat.
7 191; 118 Stat. 293) is amended by adding at the end the
8 following new paragraph:

- 1 “(46) The California Farm-to-Market Corridor.
- 2 California State Route 99 from south of Bakersfield
- 3 to Sacramento, California.”.
