3 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO SECTION 337 OF TARIFF ACT 4 OF 1930.

5 Section 337(a)(1) of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19
6 U.S.C. 1337(a)(1)) is amended—

(1) in subparagraph (A), by striking "and (E)" 1 2 and inserting "(E), and (F)"; and 3 (2) by adding at the end the following: "(F) The importation into the United 4 5 States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation by 6 7 the owner, importer, or consignee, of articles that are labeled or advertised as meeting a 8 9 United States Government standard for performance or safety, or an industry standard for 10 performance or safety, but do not in fact meet 11 12 that standard.".
