*Resolved*, That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 417) entitled “An Act to revoke a Public Land Order with respect to certain lands erroneously included in the Cibola National Wildlife Refuge, California.”, do pass with the following

**AMENDMENT:**

- 1 Page 3, after line 2, insert:
- 2 **SEC. 3. GREEN MOUNTAIN NATIONAL FOREST EXPANSION.**
  - 3       (a) *IN GENERAL.—The boundaries of the Green Moun-*
  - 4 *tain National Forest are modified to include all parcels of*
  - 5 *land depicted on the forest maps entitled “Green Mountain*
  - 6 *Expansion Area Map I” and “Green Mountain Expansion*
  - 7 *Area Map II”, each dated February 20, 2002, which shall*
  - 8 *be on file and available for public inspection in the Office*
  - 9 *of the Chief of the Forest Service, Washington, District of*
  - 10 *Columbia.*

1       (b) *MANAGEMENT.*—*Federally owned land delineated*  
2 *on the maps acquired for National Forest purposes shall*  
3 *continue to be managed in accordance with the laws (in-*  
4 *cluding regulations) applicable to the National Forest Sys-*  
5 *tem.*

6       (c) *LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND.*—*For the*  
7 *purposes of section 7 of the Land and Water Conservation*  
8 *Fund Act of 1965 (16 U.S.C. 460l-9), the boundaries of*  
9 *the Green Mountain National Forest, as adjusted by this*  
10 *Act, shall be considered to be the boundaries of the national*  
11 *forest as of January 1, 1965.*
