Mr. LATOURETTE introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To authorize the Pyramid of Remembrance Foundation to establish a memorial in the District of Columbia or its environs to soldiers who have lost their lives during peacekeeping operations, humanitarian efforts, training, terrorist attacks, or covert operations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH MEMORIAL.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Pyramid of Remembrance
5 Foundation is authorized to establish a memorial on Fed-
6 eral land within the area designated as “Area II” on the
7 map referred to in section 2(e) of the Commemorative

1 Works Act (40 U.S.C. 1002(e)), to honor members of the
2 Armed Forces of the United States who have lost their
3 lives during peacekeeping operations, humanitarian ef-
4 forts, training, terrorist attacks, or covert operations.

5 (b) COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMO-
6 RATIVE WORKS.—The Pyramid of Remembrance Founda-
7 tion shall establish the memorial authorized by this Act
8 in accordance with the Commemorative Works Act (40
9 U.S.C. 1001, et seq.), except that subsection (b) and (c)
10 of section 3 of that Act shall not apply.

11 **SEC. 2. FUNDS FOR MEMORIAL.**

12 (a) USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS PROHIBITED.—Except
13 as provided by the Commemorative Works Act, no Federal
14 funds may be used to pay any expense of the establish-
15 ment of the memorial.

16 (b) DEPOSIT OF EXCESS FUNDS.—If—

17 (1) upon payment of all expenses of the estab-
18 lishment of the memorial, including payment to the
19 Treasury of the maintenance and preservation
20 amount required by section 8(b) of the Commemora-
21 tive Works Act; or

22 (2) upon expiration of the authority for the me-
23 morial under section 10(b) of the Commemorative
24 Works Act,

1 there remains a balance of funds received for the establish-
2 ment of the memorial, the Pyramid of Remembrance
3 Foundation shall transmit that balance to the Secretary
4 of the Treasury for deposit in the account provided for
5 in section 8(b)(1) of the Commemorative Works Act.
