A BILL

To transfer jurisdiction over certain public lands from the Bureau of Land Management to the Department of Defense.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. TRANSFER OF JURISDICTION OVER CERTAIN

PUBLIC LANDS TO DEPARTMENT OF DE
FENSE.

(a) JURISDICTION TRANSFER.—The Secretary of the

Interior shall transfer to the Secretary of Defense jurisdiction over all public lands—

(1) under the jurisdiction of the Bureau of
