A BILL

To reauthorize and revise the Child Care Access Means
Parents in School Program (CCAMPIS).

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “21st Century CAMPIS
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION AND REVISION OF CCAMPIS.**

7 (a) MINIMUM GRANT.—Section 419N(b)(2)(B) of the
8 Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C.
9 1070e(b)(2)(B)) is amended by striking “\$10,000” and
10 inserting “\$30,000”.

1 (b) ELIGIBLE INSTITUTIONS.—Section 419N(b)(4)
2 of such Act is amended by striking “\$350,000” and in-
3 serting “\$250,000”.

4 (c) DEFINITION OF LOW INCOME STUDENT.—Sec-
5 tion 419N(b)(7) of such Act is amended by striking “a
6 student who is eligible to receive” and inserting “a student
7 whose family income makes the student eligible to re-
8 ceive”.

9 (d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
10 419N(g) of such Act is amended—

11 (1) by striking “\$45,000,000” and inserting
12 “\$75,000,000”;

13 (2) by striking “1999” and inserting “2005”;
14 and

15 (3) by striking “4 succeeding” and inserting “5
16 succeeding”.
