6 (a) STATE AGREEMENTS.—Section 3661 of the En7 ergy Employees Occupational Illness Compensation Pro8 gram Act of 2000 (42 U.S.C. 73850) is amended—

(1) in subsection (b) by striking "Pursuant to
 agreements under subsection (a), the" and inserting
 "The";
 (2) in subsection (c) by striking "provided in an

agreement under subsection (a), and if"; and

6 (3) in subsection (e) by striking "If provided in
7 an agreement under subsection (a)" and inserting
8 "If a panel reports a determination under subsection
9 (d)(5)".

(b) SELECTION OF PANEL MEMBERS.—Section 3661
of that Act (42 U.S.C. 73850) is further amended in subsection (d) by amending paragraph (2) to read as follows:

13 "(2) The Secretary of Health and Human Serv-14 ices shall select individuals to serve as panel mem-15 bers based on experience and competency in diag-16 nosing occupational illnesses. For each individual so 17 selected, the Secretary shall appoint that individual 18 as a panel member or obtain by contract the services 19 of that individual as a panel member.".
