A BILL

To ensure consultation with the governments of the territories of the United States with respect to trade policy and trade agreements.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Territorial Trade En-
5 hancement Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CONSULTATION WITH GOVERNMENTS OF U.S. TER-**
2 **RITORIES ON TRADE POLICY AND TRADE**
3 **AGREEMENTS.**

4 (a) ADVICE FROM EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENTS AND
5 OTHER SOURCES.—Section 132 of the Trade Act of 1974
6 (19 U.S.C. 2152) is amended in the first sentence by in-
7 serting after “appropriate” the following: “, including, but
8 not limited to, the governor of any State or territory of
9 the United States”.

10 (b) ADVICE REGARDING TRADE IN SERVICES.—Sec-
11 tion 306(c)(2)(A) of the Trade and Tariff Act of 1984
12 (19 U.S.C. 2114c(2)(A)) is amended—

13 (1) in clause (i), by inserting “and the govern-
14 ments of the territories of the United States” after
15 “State governments”;

16 (2) in clause (ii), by inserting “and the govern-
17 ments of the territories of the United States” after
18 “local governments”; and

19 (3) in clause (iii), by inserting “and the govern-
20 ments of the territories of the United States” after
21 “local governments”.
