- This Act may be cited as the "Women's Sustain-

- 6 SEC. 2. FUNDING PRIORITIES FOR WOMEN'S BUSINESS DE-
- 7 VELOPMENT CENTERS FOR FISCAL YEAR
- 8 2004.
- 9 (a) Reservation of Funds for Sustainability
- 10 Grants.—Notwithstanding section 29(k)(4)(B) of the

- 1 Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 656(k)(4)(B)), 48 percent
- 2 of the total amount made available for fiscal year 2004
- 3 for grants under section 29 of such Act shall be reserved
- 4 by the Administrator of the Small Business Administra-
- 5 tion for sustainability grants under section 29(1) of such
- 6 Act.
- 7 (b) Maximum Amount of Sustainability
- 8 Grants.—The amount of funding made available by the
- 9 Administrator of the Small Business Administration
- 10 under section 29(1) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
- 11 656(l)) to any women's business center for fiscal year
- 12 2004 shall not exceed \$125,000.
- 13 (c) Amount of Continuation Grants.—The
- 14 amount of funding made available for fiscal year 2004 by
- 15 the Administrator of the Small Business Administration
- 16 under section 29(b) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
- 17 656(b)) to any women's business center that also received
- 18 funding under such section for fiscal year 2003 shall be
- 19 equal to the lesser of—
- 20 (1) \$150,000, or
- 21 (2) the amount requested by such women's
- business center.
