A BILL

To create a system of background checks for certain workers who enter people's homes, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Domestic Consumer
- 5 Safety Act of 2003".
- 6 SEC. 2. BACKGROUND CHECKS FOR PEOPLE WHO WORK IN
- 7 HOMES.
- 8 The Federal Trade Commission shall make rules, on
- 9 the record after opportunity for an agency hearing, to as-
- 10 sure that businesses in commerce that send employees into

- 1 people's homes perform adequate and appropriate back-
- 2 ground checks on those employees.
- 3 SEC. 3. SANCTIONS.
- 4 Whoever violates a rule made by the Federal Trade
- 5 Commission under section 2 shall be liable for a civil pen-
- 6 alty of not more than \$1,000,000.
- 7 SEC. 4. DEFINITION.
- 8 As used in this Act, the term "business in commerce"
- 9 means a business that is in or affects interstate or foreign
- 10 commerce.
