AN ACT

To amend Public Law 107–10 to authorize a United States plan to endorse and obtain observer status for Taiwan at the annual summit of the World Health Assembly in May 2003 in Geneva, Switzerland, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS TO PUBLIC LAW 107-10.**

4 (a) FINDINGS.—Section 1(a) of Public Law 107-10
5 (115 Stat. 17) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
6 lowing:

7 “(14) The government of Taiwan, in response
8 to an appeal from the United Nations and the
9 United States for resources to control the spread of
10 HIV/AIDS, donated \$1,000,000 to the Global Fund
11 to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria.”.

12 (b) PLAN.—Section 1(b)(1) of Public Law 107-10
13 (115 Stat. 17) is amended by striking “May 2002” and
14 inserting “May 2003”.
