5	Command Rest and Recuperation Leave Program to pro-
6	vide or pay for transportation for a member of the Armed

8	(1) is assigned to duty inside or outside of the
9	United States, but not in an area previously des-
10	ignated for inclusion in the program;
11	(2) receives orders for deployment to an area
12	for which imminent danger pay is available under
13	section 310 of title 37, United States Code; and
14	(3) is granted leave in anticipation of such de-
