## A BILL

To amend the National Voter Registration Act of 1993 to require any individual who desires to register or reregister to vote in an election for Federal office to provide the appropriate State election official with proof that the individual is a citizen of the United States to prevent fraud in Federal elections, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Federal Election Integ-
- 5 rity Act of 2004".

6	Voter Registration Act of 1993 (42 U.S.C. 1973gg—

9	quire" and inserting "in addition to the information
10	required under subparagraph (E), may require";
11	(2) by striking "and" at the end of subpara-
12	graph (D);
13	(3) by redesignating subparagraph (E) as sub-
14	paragraph (F); and
15	(4) by inserting after subparagraph (D) the fol-
16	lowing new subparagraph:
17	"(E) shall require the applicant to provide a
18	photographic copy of any document which provides

"(1) STATES WITHOUT REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT.—In the case of a State described in
section 4(b)(1), the appropriate State or local election official may not provide any individual with a
ballot for an election for Federal office (including an
absentee ballot) unless the individual provides the official with a photographic copy of any document
which provides proof that the individual is a citizen
of the United States, in accordance with guidelines
established by the Election Administration Commission in consultation with the Secretary of Homeland
Security and the Secretary of State.

"(2) STATES PERMITTING SAME-DAY REGISTRA-TION.—In the case of a State described in section 4(b)(2), the appropriate State or local election official may not permit any individual to register to vote in an election for Federal office (including an individual who desires to register to vote at the polling place at the time of voting in the election) unless the individual provides the official with a photographic copy of any document which provides proof that the individual is a citizen of the United States, in ac-

1	cordance with guidelines established by the Election	
2	Administration Commission in consultation with the	
3	Secretary of Homeland Security and the Secretary	
4	of State.".	
5	(2) Conforming amendment.—Section 4(b)

9	SEC. 3. REQUIRING VOTERS TO PROVIDE PHOTO IDENTI-	
10	FICATION.	
11	(a) In General.—Section 303(b) of the Help Amer-	
12	ica Vote Act of 2002 (42 U.S.C. 15483(b)) is amended—	
13	(1) in the heading, by striking "FOR VOTERS	
14	Who Register by Mail" and inserting "for Pro-	
15	VIDING PHOTO IDENTIFICATION"; and	
16	(2) by striking paragraphs (1) through (3) and	
17	inserting the following:	
18	"(1) Individuals voting in Person.—Not-	
19	withstanding any other provision of law, the appro-	
20	priate State or local election official may not provide	
21	a ballot for an election for Federal office (including	
22	a provisional ballot under section 302(a)) to an indi-	
23	vidual who desires to vote in person unless the indi-	
24	vidual presents to the official a current and valid	
25	photo identification.
