5 Any reimbursement provided by the Secretary of Defense to a member of the Armed Forces for the cost of 6 protective body armor purchased by the member, or by 7 another person on behalf of the member, for use by the 8 member while deployed in connection with Operation 9 Noble Eagle, Operation Enduring Freedom, or Operation 10 Iraqi Freedom shall include reimbursement for any costs 11 12 incurred by the member, or by another person on behalf of the member, to deliver the body armor to the member. 13

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
