- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1860C–1(b) of the Social
- 7 Security Act, as added by section 241 of the Medicare Pre-

- 1 scription Drug, Improvement, and Modernization Act of
- 2 2003 (Public Law 108–173), is amended by adding at the
- 3 end the following:
- 4 "(3) NO CCA AREAS WITHIN RHODE ISLAND.—
- 5 A CCA area shall not include an MSA any portion
- of which is within the State of Rhode Island.".
- 7 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 8 this section shall take effect as if included in the enact-
- 9 ment of the Medicare Prescription Drug, Improvement,
- 10 and Modernization Act of 2003 (Public Law 108–173).

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
