To name the lake known as Falls Lake in North Carolina after United States Senator Jesse Helms.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. JESSE HELMS LAKE.
- 4 (a) In General.—The lake described in subsection
- 5 (b) and known as Falls Lake shall be known and des-
- 6 ignated as "Jesse Helms Lake".
- 7 (b) Lake Described.—The lake referred to in sub-
- 8 section (a) is—
- 9 (1) north of the northern boundary of Raleigh,
- North Carolina;

1	(2) located along a 21 mile stretch of the Neuse
2	River, which runs in a northwest to southeast direc-
3	tion;
4	(3) approximately 11 miles wide at its widest
5	point; and
6	(4) centered at 36 degrees 1.75 minutes North,
7	78 degrees 43.25 minutes West.
8	(c) References.—Any reference in any law, regula-
9	tion, document, record, map, or other paper of the United
10	States to the lake referred to in subsection (a) is deemed
11	to be a reference to Jesse Helms Lake.
