3 SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT FOR BORDER PATROL UNI-4 FORMS.

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, all uni-6 forms procured for the use of Border Patrol agents shall 7 be manufactured in the United States substantially all 8 from articles, materials, or supplies mined, produced, or 9 manufactured, as the case may be, in the United States.
