1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT FOR BORDER PATROL UNI-**
4 **FORMS.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, all uni-
6 forms procured for the use of Border Patrol agents shall
7 be manufactured in the United States substantially all
8 from articles, materials, or supplies mined, produced, or
9 manufactured, as the case may be, in the United States.
