- 3 SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION.
- 4 The canal located in El Paso, Texas, constructed as
- 5 part of the Rio Grande canalization project under the Act
- 6 entitled "An Act authorizing construction, operation, and
- 7 maintenance of Rio Grande canalization project and au-
- 8 thorizing appropriation for that purpose", approved June

- 1 4, 1936 (49 Stat. 1463), and known as the "Rio Grande
- 2 American Canal" shall be redesignated and known as the
- 3 "Travis C. Johnson Canal".
- 4 SEC. 2. REFERENCES.
- 5 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
- 6 paper, or other record of the United States to the canal
- 7 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
- 8 to the "Travis C. Johnson Canal".
