3 **SECTION 1. NATIONAL PARK SERVICE STUDY REGARDING**

4 **THE MEMORIAL TO EDMUND S. MUSKIE.**

5 (a) STUDY.—The Secretary of the Interior shall con-
6 duct a special resources study to determine the suitability
7 and feasibility of designating the memorial to Edmund S.

1 Muskie located in Rumford, Maine, as a unit of the Na-
2 tional Park System.

3 (b) STUDY PROCESS AND COMPLETION.—Section
4 8(c) of Public Law 91–383 (16 U.S.C. 1a–5(c)) shall
5 apply to the conduct and completion of the study required
6 by this section.

7 (c) REPORT.—The Secretary shall submit a report
8 describing the results of the study required by this section
9 to the Committee on Resources of the House of Represent-
10 atives and the Committee on Energy and Natural Re-
11 sources of the Senate.
