- 3 (b) STUDY PROCESS AND COMPLETION.—Section
- 4 8(c) of Public Law 91–383 (16 U.S.C. 1a–5(c)) shall
- 5 apply to the conduct and completion of the study required
- 6 by this section.
- 7 (c) Report.—The Secretary shall submit a report
- 8 describing the results of the study required by this section
- 9 to the Committee on Resources of the House of Represent-
- 10 atives and the Committee on Energy and Natural Re-
- 11 sources of the Senate.
