4	(a) In General.—Section 1006 of the Legislative
5	Branch Appropriations Act, 2004 (2 U.S.C. 1901 note),
6	is amended—
7	(1) in the heading, by striking "Training, De-
8	TAILING, AND HIRING" and inserting "TRAINING
9	AND DETAILING";
10	(2) by striking "(a)" and the heading of sub-
11	section (a);
12	(3) by striking subsection (b) and redesignating
13	paragraphs (1) and (2) of subsection (a) as sub-
14	sections (a) and (b); and
15	(4) in subsection (b) (as so redesignated), by
16	striking "paragraph (1)" and inserting "subsection
17	(a)".
18	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
19	subsection (a) shall take effect as if included in the enact-
20	ment of the Legislative Branch Appropriations Act, 2004.
