AN ACT

To facilitate the resolution of a minor boundary encroachment on lands of the Union Pacific Railroad Company in Tipton, California, which were originally conveyed by the United States as part of the right-of-way granted for the construction of transcontinental railroads.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. RELEASE OF UNITED STATES INTERESTS IN
- 4 CERTAIN RAILROAD GRANT LANDS IN TIP-
- 5 TON, CALIFORNIA.
- 6 (a) Property Defined.—In this section, the term
- 7 "property" means that portion of the existing building lo-
- 8 cated at 615 North Burnett Road in Tipton, California,
- 9 which encroaches upon land that, subject to a reversionary
- 10 interest, was conveyed by the United States pursuant to
- 11 the Act of July 27, 1866 (14 Stat. 292).
- 12 (b) Release of Interests in Property.—There
- 13 is hereby released, without consideration, all right, title,
- 14 and interest of the United States in and to the surface
- 15 portion of the property. The United States retains any
- 16 subsurface mineral rights held by the United States as of
- 17 the date of the enactment of this Act associated with the
- 18 property.
- 19 (c) Instrument of Release.—The Secretary of
- 20 the Interior shall execute and file in the appropriate office
- 21 a deed of release, amended deed, or other appropriate in-

- 1 strument effectuating the release of interests made by sub-
- 2 section (b).
