Ms. WATSON (for herself and Mr. BURTON of Indiana) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To direct the Consumer Product Safety Commission to issue a rule banning children's toys containing mercury.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TOYS CONTAINING MERCURY AS BANNED HAZ-**

4 **ARDOUS PRODUCTS.**

5 (a) **PRODUCT BANNED.**—Not later than 6 months
6 after the date of enactment of this Act, the Consumer
7 Product Safety Commission shall, pursuant to section 8
8 of the Consumer Product Safety Act (15 U.S.C. 2057),
9 promulgate a rule under section 9 of such Act, declaring

1 mercury-containing toys to be banned hazardous products
2 under such Act.

3 (b) DEFINITION OF MERCURY-CONTAINING TOYS.—

4 As used in this Act, the term “mercury-containing toy”
5 means any toy or other product that contains mercury and
6 is designed primarily for, or marketed primarily to chil-
7 dren.
