WAIVER OF VISA PROCESSING FEES FOR NON-4 IMMIGRANT VISITORS WHO ARE NATIONALS 5 OF COUNTRIES PROVIDING COMBAT TROOPS 6 IN AFGHANISTAN AND IRAQ. 7 For such period as the Secretary of State, in con-8 sultation with the Secretary of Defense, determines that a foreign country is providing troops for combat oper-

10 ations in both Afghanistan and Iraq, there shall no be visa
