A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Transportation to conduct a test to determine the costs and benefits of requiring jetpropelled aircraft taking off from Newark International Airport, New Jersey, to conduct ascents over the ocean, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. TEST OF AIRCRAFT OCEAN ROUTING.
- 4 (a) In General.—In order to examine an option for
- 5 reducing aircraft noise over communities in New Jersey,
- 6 the Secretary of Transportation shall conduct a 6-month
- 7 test to determine the costs and benefits of requiring jet-

- 1 propelled aircraft to conduct ascents after taking off from
- 2 Newark International Airport, New Jersey, over the
- 3 ocean.
- 4 (b) Commencement Deadline.—The Secretary
- 5 shall commence the test under this section not later than
- 6 45 days after the date of enactment of this Act.

7 SEC. 2. REPORT.

- 8 (a) In General.—Not later than 1 year after the
- 9 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Transpor-
- 10 tation shall transmit to Congress a report on the results
- 11 of the test conducted under section 1.
- 12 (b) CONTENTS.—The report shall include an analysis
- 13 of the effects on noise reduction of ocean routing of air-
- 14 craft taking off from Newark International Airport and
- 15 any recommendations and comments of the Secretary con-
- 16 cerning ocean routing of air carrier aircraft taking off
- 17 from Newark International Airport.

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
