# A BILL

To provide emergency assistance to producers that have incurred losses in a 2004 crop due to a disaster.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Emergency Agricul-
- 5 tural Disaster Assistance Act of 2004".
- 6 SEC. 2. CROP LOSS ASSISTANCE.
- 7 (a) In General.—The Secretary of Agriculture (re-
- 8 ferred to in this Act as the "Secretary") shall use such
- 9 sums as are necessary of the funds of the Commodity
- 10 Credit Corporation to make emergency financial assist-

- 1 ance available to producers on a farm that have incurred
- 2 losses in a 2004 crop due to a disaster, as determined
- 3 by the Secretary.
- 4 (b) Administration.—Subject to subsection (a), the
- 5 Secretary shall make assistance available under this sec-
- 6 tion in the same manner as provided under section 1102
- 7 of the Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug
- 8 Administration, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act,
- 9 1999 (7 U.S.C. 1421 note; Public Law 105–277), includ-
- 10 ing using the same loss thresholds as were used in admin-
- 11 istering that section.
- 12 (c) QUALIFYING LOSSES.—Assistance under this sec-
- 13 tion may be made for losses associated with crops that
- 14 are, as determined by the Secretary—
- 15 (1) quantity losses;
- 16 (2) quality losses; or
- 17 (3) severe economic losses due to damaging
- weather or related condition.
- 19 (d) Crops Covered.—Assistance under this section
- 20 shall be applicable to losses for all crops (including losses
- 21 of trees from which a crop is harvested, livestock, and fish-
- 22 eries), as determined by the Secretary, due to disasters.
- 23 (e) Crop Insurance.—In carrying out this section,
- 24 the Secretary shall not discriminate against or penalize
- 25 producers on a farm that have purchased crop insurance

- 1 under the Federal Crop Insurance Act (7 U.S.C. 1501 et
- 2 seq.).
- 3 SEC. 3. COMMODITY CREDIT CORPORATION.
- 4 The Secretary shall use the funds, facilities, and au-
- 5 thorities of the Commodity Credit Corporation to carry
- 6 out this Act.

#### 7 SEC. 4. EMERGENCY DESIGNATION.

- 8 The entire amount made available under this Act is
- 9 designated by Congress as an emergency requirement pur-
- 10 suant to section 402 of S. Con. Res. 95 (108th Congress),
- 11 as made applicable to the House of Representatives by H.
- 12 Res. 649 (108th Congress).
- 13 SEC. 5. REGULATIONS.
- 14 (a) In General.—The Secretary may promulgate
- 15 such regulations as are necessary to implement this Act.
- 16 (b) Procedure.—The promulgation of the regula-
- 17 tions and administration of this Act shall be made without
- 18 regard to—
- 19 (1) the notice and comment provisions of sec-
- tion 553 of title 5, United States Code;
- 21 (2) the Statement of Policy of the Secretary of
- Agriculture effective July 24, 1971 (36 Fed. Reg.
- 23 13804), relating to notices of proposed rulemaking
- and public participation in rulemaking; and

- 1 (3) chapter 35 of title 44, United States Code
- 2 (commonly known as the "Paperwork Reduction
- 3 Act'').
- 4 (c) Congressional Review of Agency Rule-
- 5 MAKING.—In carrying out this section, the Secretary shall
- 6 use the authority provided under section 808 of title 5,
- 7 United States Code.
