A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to modernize the Medicare Program by ensuring that appropriate preventive services are covered under such program.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Medicare Preventive
- 5 Services Coverage Act of 2004".

19	provement, and Modernization Act of 2003 (Public Law
20	108–173; 117 Stat. 2303), is amended by adding at the
21	end the following new subparagraph:
22	"(L) Additional preventive services (as defined
23	in subsection (bbb)(1)).".

- 1 (e) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 2 this section shall apply to services furnished on or after

3 the date of enactment of this Act.
