## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a sale of oil and gas leases on certain submerged lands of the outer Continental Shelf in the Eastern Gulf of Mexico.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Energy Independence
- 5 for a Strong America Act of 2004".
- 6 SEC. 2. LEASE SALE REQUIRED.
- 7 The Secretary of the Interior shall, as soon as prac-
- 8 ticable after the date of the enactment of this Act and

under section 8 of the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act (43 U.S.C. 1337), conduct a sale of oil and gas leases on 3 all submerged lands of the outer Continental Shelf in the 4 Eastern Gulf of Mexico that— (1) are depicted as "Leased or Deferred—Not 5 6 Offered" on the Minerals Management Service document entitled "Eastern Gulf of Mexico Lease Sale 7 181, December 2001 Lease Terms, Economic Condi-8 9 tions, Stipulations, and Deferred Blocks for the FINAL NOTICE OF SALE 181"; and 10 11 (2) are not subject to a lease under that sec-12 tion.
