To amend title 10, United States Code, to require emergency contraception to be included on the uniform formulary of pharmaceutical agents of the pharmacy benefits program of the Department of Defense.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

1	SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT TO INCLUDE EMERGENCY CON-
2	TRACEPTION ON UNIFORM FORMULARY OF
3	PHARMACEUTICAL AGENTS OF THE PHAR-
4	MACY BENEFITS PROGRAM OF THE DEPART-
5	MENT OF DEFENSE.
6	Section 1074g(a) of title 10, United States Code, is
7	amended by adding at the end the following new para-
8	graph:
9	"(9)(A) Emergency contraception shall be included
10	on the uniform formulary.
11	"(B) Notwithstanding paragraph (4), no prior au-
12	thorization may be required for emergency contraception.
13	Nothing in the preceding sentence may be construed as
14	waiving any provision of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cos-
15	metic Act (21 U.S.C. 301 et seq.) or any other Act admin-
16	istered by the Food and Drug Administration.
17	"(C) In this paragraph, the term 'emergency contra-
18	ception' means a drug, drug regimen, or device that is—
19	"(i) used postcoitally;
20	"(ii) prevents pregnancy by delaying ovulation,
21	preventing fertilization of an egg, or preventing im-
22	plantation of an egg in a uterus; and
23	"(iii) is approved by the Food and Drug Ad-
24	ministration.".
