## A BILL

To make funds available to pay the United States prisoners of war that brought suit against the Government of Iraq in the case of Acree v. Republic of Iraq.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PAYMENTS TO UNITED STATES PRISONERS OF
- 4 WAR BASED ON COURT JUDGMENT.
- 5 (a) Payments.—The Secretary of the Treasury shall
- 6 pay, out of funds described in subsection (b), \$1,000,000
- 7 to each of the 17 plaintiffs in the case of Acree v. Republic
- 8 of Iraq, 271 F.Supp. 2d 179 (D.D.C. 2003) that were held
- 9 captive by Iraq during the first Gulf War.

- 1 (b) Source of Funds.—\$17,000,000 shall be avail-
- 2 able, from unobligated funds appropriated under chapter
- 3 2 of title II of the Emergency Supplemental Appropria-
- 4 tions Act for Defense and for the Reconstruction of Iraq
- 5 and Afghanistan, 2004, under the heading "OTHER BI-
- 6 LATERAL ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE—FUNDS AP-
- 7 PROPRIATED TO THE PRESIDENT—IRAQ RELIEF AND RE-
- 8 CONSTRUCTION FUND", for payments under subsection
- 9 (a).
