A BILL

Making emergency supplemental appropriations for the fiscal
year ending September 30, 2004, for additional disaster
assistance.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following sums are appropriated, out of any
4 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the
5 fiscal year ending September 30, 2004, to provide emer-
6 gency supplemental appropriations for additional disaster
7 assistance, namely:

1 DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY
2 EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE
3 DISASTER RELIEF

4 For an additional amount for “Disaster Relief”,
5 \$2,000,000,000, to remain available until expended, of
6 which up to \$30,000,000 may be transferred to “SMALL
7 BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION—SALARIES AND EX-
8 PENSES”, for administrative expenses to carry out the dis-
9 aster loans program authorized by section 7(b) of the
10 Small Business Act: *Provided*, That the amounts provided
11 herein are designated as an emergency requirement pursu-
12 ant to section 402 of S. Con. Res. 95 (108th Congress),
13 as made applicable to the House of Representatives by H.
14 Res. 649 (108th Congress) and applicable to the Senate
15 by section 14007 of Public Law 108–287.

16 This Act may be cited as the “Emergency Supple-
17 mental Appropriations for Disaster Relief Act, 2004”.
