## **AN ACT**

To extend water contracts between the United States and specific irrigation districts and the City of Helena in Montana, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Montana Water Con-
- 3 tracts Extension Act of 2004".
- 4 SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF WATER CONTRACTS.
- 5 (a) AUTHORITY TO EXTEND.—The Secretary of the
- 6 Interior may extend each of the water contracts listed in
- 7 subsection (b) until the earlier of—
- 8 (1) the expiration of the 2-year period begin-
- 9 ning on the date on which the contract would expire
- but for this section; or
- 11 (2) the date on which a new long-term water
- contract is executed by the parties to the contract
- listed in subsection (b).
- 14 (b) Extended Contracts.—The water contracts
- 15 referred to in subsection (a) are the following:
- 16 (1) Contract Number 14–06–600–2078, as
- amended, for purchase of water between the United
- 18 States of America and the City of Helena, Montana.
- 19 (2) Contract Number 14–06–600–2079, as
- amended, between the United States of America and
- 21 the Helena Valley Irrigation District for water serv-
- ice.
- 23 (3) Contract Number 14–06–600–8734, as
- amended, between the United States of America and
- 25 the Toston Irrigation District for water service.

1	(4) Contract number 14–06–600–3592, as
2	amended, between the United States and the Clark
3	Canyon Water Supply Company, Inc., for water
4	service and for a supplemental supply.
5	(5) Contract number 14–06–600–3593, as
6	amended, between the United States and the East
7	Bench Irrigation District for water service.
