A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, with respect to stored electronic communications.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Internet Privacy Pro-
- 5 tection Act of 2004".
- 6 SEC. 2. STORED ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS.
- 7 (a) In General.—Chapter 121 of title 18, United
- 8 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 9 lowing:

1 "§ 2713. Improper access by service provider

- 2 "(a) Offense.—Except as provided in subsection
- 3 (b), whoever, being a provider of electronic communication
- 4 service, intentionally accesses the contents of a stored elec-
- 5 tronic communication while held in electronic storage by
- 6 that provider shall be fined not more than \$5,000.
- 7 "(b) Exceptions.—It is not an offense under sub-
- 8 section (a) if the access is a necessary incident to the ren-
- 9 dition of the electronic communication service or compli-
- 10 ance with section 2702.".
- 11 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
- 12 at the beginning of chapter 121 of title 18, United States
- 13 Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new
- 14 item:

"2713. Improper access by service provider.".
