A BILL

To provide for a certificate recognizing employees of defense companies for contributions to the national defense during the Cold War.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. CERTIFICATES OF RECOGNITION FOR EMPLOY-
- 4 EES OF DEFENSE COMPANIES DURING THE
- 5 COLD WAR.
- 6 (a) Preparation of Certificates.—The Sec-
- 7 retary of Defense shall prepare a certificate recognizing
- 8 the contributions to the national defense during the Cold
- 9 War by eligible persons employed by defense companies

- 1 and shall provide the certificate to such persons, in accord-
- 2 ance with this Act.
- 3 (b) Eligible Persons.—A person who was em-
- 4 ployed by an eligible defense company during the Cold
- 5 War is eligible to receive a certificate under this Act.
- 6 (c) APPLICATION.—The Secretary shall provide a cer-
- 7 tificate prepared under subsection (a) to any eligible per-
- 8 son who submits an application to the Secretary at such
- 9 a time, in such manner, and containing such information
- 10 and assurances as the Secretary may require.
- 11 (d) Issuance to Representative of De-
- 12 CEASED.—If an eligible person dies before being issued a
- 13 certificate under this Act, a representative of that person
- 14 may apply for a certificate and the certificate may be pro-
- 15 vided to such representative.
- 16 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.
- 17 In this Act, the following definitions apply:
- 18 (1) COLD WAR.—The term "Cold War" means
- the period beginning on September 2, 1945, and
- ending on December 26, 1991.
- 21 (2) ELIGIBLE DEFENSE COMPANY.—The term
- 22 "eligible defense company" means a private entity
- engaged in providing significant and substantial de-
- 24 fense-related systems, products, or services to the

- 1 Department of Defense or the Department of En-
- 2 ergy (or any predecessor agency).
