## A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to expand the risk pools that qualify for high risk pool grants.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "High Risk Pool Flexi-
- 5 bility Act of 2004".
- 6 SEC. 2. REVISION OF DEFINITION OF QUALIFIED HIGH
- 7 RISK POOL.
- 8 Section 2745(d) of the Public Health Service Act (42
- 9 U.S.C. 300gg-45(d)) is amended to read as follows:
- 10 "(d) Definitions.—For purposes of this section:

"(1) QUALIFIED HIGH RISK POOL.—The term 1 2 'qualified high risk pool' has the meaning given such 3 term in section 2744(c)(2), except that a State may elect to meet the requirement of subparagraph (A) 4 5 of such section (insofar as it requires the provision of coverage to all eligible individuals) through pro-6 7 viding for the enrollment of eligible individuals through an acceptable alternative mechanism (as de-8 9 fined for purposes of section 2744) that includes a high risk pool as a component. 10

> "(2) STATE.—The term 'State' means any of the 50 States and the District of Columbia.".

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
