To amend title 49, United States Code, to ensure that the National Driver Registry includes certain information.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. NATIONAL DRIVER REGISTRY ENHANCEMENT.

4 (a) INFORMATION REGARDING CERTAIN DRIVERS.—
5 Section 30304(b)(1) of title 49, United States Code, is
6 amended—

7 (1) by redesignating subparagraphs (B) and
8 (C) as subparagraphs (C) and (D), respectively; and
9 (2) by inserting after subparagraph (A) the fol10 lowing:

"(B) information that specifies if an individual has been convicted in the previous 10
years under the laws of the State of operating
a motor vehicle under the influence of, or impaired by, alcohol or a controlled substance;".

6 (b) APPLICATION.—The amendments made by sub7 section (a) shall apply to a conviction described in section
8 30304(b)(1)(B) of title 49, United States Code, that oc9 curs on or after the date of enactment of this Act.

10 SEC. 2. ACCESS TO REGISTER INFORMATION.

Section 30305(b) of title 49, United States Code, isamended by adding at the end the following:

13 "(12) A State or local prosecutor and district 14 attorney may request the chief driver licensing offi-15 cial of a State to obtain information under sub-16 section (a) about an individual who is under inves-17 tigation for a traffic related offense. A prosecutor 18 and a district attorney may receive the informa-19 tion.".
